About the Challenger Football and Cheer Program

The Challenger program is non-competitive and no score will be kept. Each player wears flags and the opponent will remove the flag to stop the play. If a participant is on a wheelchair or walker the flag will be placed in a location that won't interfere with the operation of the device.

Everyone participates!!! No one is turned away.

An individual's parent or guardian must request for an individual to participate in the Challenger Football and Cheer program. The program is open to all physically and mentally challenged boys and girls **over the age of 5** (as of July 1, 2010).

Mentoring and a "buddy" system are used to assist the Challenger football player or cheerleader on the field, whenever possible, players are encouraged to make plays and cheer themselves.




The following are required for each participant to be kept for league records

- Copy of birth certificate
- Wallet size picture
- Physical
